Enira, Reserva, Bessa Valley, Bulgaria (Vg) Smooth and generous with forest fruits, dark chocolate, and sweet spice. A touch of oak rounds out the full body and ripe tannins.	72

Vinho Verde, Quintas do Homem, <i>Minho, Portugal</i> (Vg) Light, crisp, and slightly effervescent, this Vinho Verde displays bright notes of wild berries, green apple, and citrus.	39
