Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine sur Lie 'Les Roches Noires', Marcel Martin, Loire, France 36
Dry, zesty and refreshing with citrus, green apple and wet stone. Bright acidity, a touch of salinity and a clean, mineral finish. A go-to wine for seafood lovers.

Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie, Casalforte, Veneto, Italy (V) 35
Bright, fresh & fruity notes of pear, crisp green apple and citrus with underlying hints of honeysuckle, minerality & a refreshing, dry finish. A well-balanced, easy-drinking Italian white.

L'Atelier, Maison Marlère, Cotes de Gascogne, France 32
Fresh and aromatic exotic notes are mixed with floral scents such as citrus, peach, grapefruit & elderflower. Its crispness and great persistence will provide beautiful enjoyment.

1769 Sauvignon Blanc, Poverty Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand (Vg) 45
Bright and refreshing with notes of passionfruit, lime and gooseberry, balanced by crisp citrus acidity and a clean mineral finish typical of classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc.

Le Chatenai Sancerre, Paul Regis, Loire Valley, France 76
Crisp and dry with lemon, grapefruit and green apple aromas, bright acidity, flinty minerality and a long, clean, citrus finish.

Rolona Gavi di Gavi, Castellari Bergaglio Piemonte, Italy (Vg) 58
Fresh orchard and citrus fruits, subtle floral notes, wet stone minerality, and a crisp, vibrant acidic backbone.

Albariño, Sandboy, Rias Baixas, Spain (Vg) 48
A versatile white with aromas of ripe peach, apricot, and honeysuckle delivering flavours of citrus, stone fruit, a hint of salinity and a touch of spice.

Chablis 1er Cru Beauroy, Domaine Michaut Freres, Burgundy, France (Vg) 99
Mineral-driven with lemon, chalk, and white flowers. Slight creaminess from lees contact. Ideal with scallops & sole

Rioja Blanco Fermentado En Barrica, Bodegas Campillo, Rioja, Spain (Vg) 38
Round, crisp, and well-structured with balanced acidity, displaying flavors of fresh pear, lemon curd, and a long, buttery finish.

Pinot Gris, Villa Wolf, Pfalz, Germany (Vg) 45
Full-bodied, this unoaked Pinot Gris boasts bright aromatics of ripe grapefruit, melon and pear. Notes of citrus oil and spice linger on the finish, making it a great food wine

Chardonnay, Ataraxia, Hemel-en-Aarde, South Africa (Vg) 68
Well-balanced, Elegant and rounded with peach, citrus, and light oak. Smooth and structured—an excellent pairing with halibut.

Exceptional Harvest, Bodegas Ximénez Spínola, Jerez, Spain 75
Unique and opulent with aromas of dried fig, golden raisins, and orange zest. The palate is luscious yet balanced with acidity, showing notes of honeyed stone fruit, toasted nuts and a soft saline finish. A rare, off-dry white!
